### FEEDING DIRECTIONS

**BURKMANN MILKMASTER 38** is designed for feeding programs where the forage dry matter intake is approximately 75% corn silage and 25% legume hay. An 18% protein mix should be used with excellent hay and a 20% protein mix should be used with fair quality hay. Mix according to guidelines below.

| Ground Shelled Corn | 1225           |      | 1350 |      |
| Ground Ear Corn     |                | 1175 |      | 1300 |
| MILKMASTER 38       | 775            | 825  | 650  | 700  |

Feed the above mixtures at the rate of approximately one pound per three pounds of milk produced. For added palatability 5 to 7 1/2% molasses can be substituted for corn.
